Job description

Roofers will have knowledge of roofing plans, preparations for installation, installation procedures, systems relevant to a specialist strand or strands, re-roofing and flashings and penetrations.

They will also be able to perform the following:

- Relevant calculations
- Interpret roofing plans and specifications
- Form and install flashings and carry out installation or application (applicable to chosen strand)

Qualifications required

There are no mandatory requirements; you will gain skills on the job.

General requirements

Roofers need to be fit and healthy, and should have a strong back and arms as they may be required to do a lot of lifting. They also need good hand-eye co-ordination and a good sense of balance.

Training costs

There is a weekly cost over a two year period. The weekly cost varies depending on the roofing strand.

Career path

Job opportunities for roofers have increased significantly in the last few years, especially due to the Christchurch earthquakes. Obtaining The National Certificate in Roofing (Installer) (Level 4) will provide apprentices with a nationally recognised qualification.
